



Position Title: Family Advocate Coordinator

(rev_mrr_4.5.21)

Job Description:

The Family Advocate Coordinator is responsible for providing coordination of social services for clients from a strength-based model of service and have knowledge using a trauma informed approach to providing services. The candidate should be comfortable sharing the Gospel, educating families on healthy lifestyles choices, and connecting them with available resources. In this role, the candidate must show excellence in collaborating with our medical, educational, and leadership staff. The position holder should possess excellent communication and interpersonal skills and have a heart to serve in a ministry setting.

Type of Position: 20 to 25 hours per week

Reports To: Educational Services Coordinator

Location: Coatesville, West Chester, or Kennett Square; able to float between offices as needed

Responsibilities:

- Leads efforts in planning, developing, organizing, implementing, evaluating, and directing the ministries social services programs and procedures
- Assess physical, medical, educational, emotional, and spiritual needs for each client
- Share agency's mission and services to client including the informed consent for services
- Facilitates goal setting with client by evaluating social and familial information
- Utilizes appropriate materials (workbooks, etc.) in helping client to achieve goals
- Initiates and coordinates referrals both internally and externally to community partners and churches
- Meets regularly with supervisor to ensure goals are being met and discuss client case load
- Collaborates with medical, educational, and other staff as needed to coordinate care of clients across departments and programs
- Keeps clear, concise records of each appointment, both physical and electronic
- Creates and maintains an atmosphere of warmth, personal interest, and calm environment throughout client's experience.
- Establishes a scriptural basis for hope and for dealing with issues
- Make written and oral reports/recommendations concerning the social service program
- Provides regular reporting of statistics and reports as needed
- Analyzes client demographical information using database software.
- Works with the Development Director to prepare an annual report.

Character Qualifications:

- This person must be highly self-motivated and have strong leadership and administrative abilities
- Dependable and able to carry out responsibilities without supervision
- Works well individually and as part of a team, always honoring all relationships within the ministry and in the community

- Possess strong computer software skills: Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite (Word, Outlook, Excel, PowerPoint), and Internet operating systems
- Has accepted Jesus Christ as personal Savior and possesses a passion for evangelism
- Has passion for helping women and families who are facing crisis situations
- Full agreement with the center's mission statement, policy and procedures, and other operating documents
- Have a strong administrative ability to shift priorities while working with multiple disciplines
- Expresses a sincere desire to reach out to abortion-vulnerable individuals, their families and support network
- Agrees with and has ability to hold to our standard of confidentiality
- Ability to receive direction and feedback.
- Ability to follow Matthew 18 example of conflict resolution
- Has excellent communication skills and is comfortable with public speaking
- Leads a life of purity and honors the commitment of marriage
- Maintains a consistent life-affirming lifestyle and abstains from referring/advising for an abortion

Public Relations:

- Attends professional networking and community resource meetings
- Networks with area hospitals, clinics, and social service agencies to foster the credibility and visibility of the agency within the community. Evaluates other social service agencies as resources and updates staff and files concerning them
- Speaks to church and community groups about her work with the agency
- Be available to work on an occasional evening or weekend for outreach and speaking engagements

- Bachelor degree in psychology, social work (BSW) or related field.
- Bilingual skillset in English and Spanish preferred, but not required

Working Conditions/Physical Demands:

- Work in a standard office environment

Mission Statement:

We are a pregnancy care medical center that exists to educate and empower individuals and their families to make life affirming choices.

Chester County Women's Services Statement of Faith

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, infallible Word of God.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

2. We believe that there is only one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

4. Ephesians 2:8-10 "FOR it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

5. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life and to perform good works.

John 14:16-18 "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever—the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you."
